Legal advice sort and letter provided in response to Eric Ganzer. The legal advice confirms the CEO's position that the Shire has no jurisdiction over this issue as it is unallocated Crown land.

Corella Management Update:

In collaboration with the community, the Shire conducted a comprehensive study on corella nesting habits and daily flight patterns. We engaged with neighbouring Local Governments to exchange insights on managing this issue. Through this partnership, we connected with the West Australian Field & Game Association, highly recommended for their expertise.

Upon contacting WAFGA, the community's gathered data was shared, aiding in the development of a culling strategy. A successful cull took place on Saturday, January 3rd, and Sunday, January 4th. We are currently awaiting final tally figures.

Furthermore, the Shire has initiated discussions with Wheatbelt Natural Resource Management. This group collaborates with local governments and CBH to explore sustainable, long-term solutions for corella management.

Footpath Maintenance Update:

Over the past year, the Shire has undertaken substantial repairs on its footpath network. These efforts have encompassed the installation of bitumen ramps to alleviate the height differential between concrete footpaths and road surfaces. While a significant amount of repairs have been

carried out, we are still working through the issue, with the aim to have all repairs carried out before the end of the financial year.
