After 8pm on the 10th of October, a line of bright objects can be seen. Starting from the east northeast, a full Moon rises. Further westward is the planet Jupiter, visible as a bright star. Even further to the west, Saturn can be seen, as a fainter star than Jupiter.

When to look: After 8pm, October the 10th Which direction to look: From the eastnortheast horizon, westward.
