DOWERIN PRISON CAMP

For a few years the Shire of Wongan-Ballidu has supported the Department of Corrective Services with their prisoner work camps and section 95 activities. The Department of Corrective Services offers a resource to the community through unskilled or semi-skilled labour undertaken by low risk, minimumsecurity prisoners. The aim of the program is to communities in improving support infrastructure and assets. adds value and complements other projects and initiatives already being undertaken by community volunteers. The projects are usually skills-based and offers the potential to involve the prison education centre and the local TAFE in accreditation training opportunities.

This year the Dowerin Prison Camp has supported Shire activities through footpath replacement and paving works. The Shire provide the materials, tools and machinery as well as supervision of the work whilst the labour is completed by prisoners involved in the program.
