

WHAT TO DO IN A STORM?


Wondering what to do when you need assistance in a storm?

If you require Police, Fire and Rescue or Ambulance assistance - call 000.

If you need SES assistance - call 132 500. SES can provide assistance with storm damage to your property to help make it immediately safe until contractors can be arranged.

Tree over the road - If urgent and causing immediate danger - contact the Shire's emergency line on 9671 2570 . If not urgent please call the Shire Office during business hours on 9671 2500.

Please note road sweepers have been arranged for Wednesday, Thursday and Friday this week to attend to storm clean up in both Wongan Hills and Ballidu.

ROADWORKS

- CONSTRUCTION CREW: Road Widening on Waddington Road. Traffic Management in place (Traffic Lights).
- MAINTENANCE GRADERS: Area 1 Road Widening on Ballidu East Road. Traffic Management in place. Area 2 - Rabbit Proof Fence Road, Cadoux North Road followed by Cadoux South Road. Traffic Management in place.
- MAINTENANCE CREW Pothole Repairs and Guidepost Replacement in various areas. Traffic Management in place.



BURAKIN-WIALKI ROAD

In 2019 the Burakin-Wialki Road was titled as the fourth-riskiest road in the RAC's "Riskiest Roads" ranking in WA. The Shire of Wongan-Ballidu is committed to increasing the safety of our road network and following this rating, we sought funding through the Regional Road Group Funding Program, which is a partnership between The State Government and the Shire of Wongan-Ballidu to carry out works to make this road safer.

In the 2022-2023 financial year, we secured the funding and works have since been carried out. This allowed for the widening of the initial 3-kilometre section. Subsequently, the Shire successfully obtained additional funding to finalise the road widening as part of the Capital Works Program for the 2023-2024 fiscal year.

The final phase of widening for this road was completed last week. The initial 6.8 kilometres of road has now been expanded to a 12-metre formation, featuring an 8-metre seal, as an improvement from the original 10-metre formation with a 3.5-metre seal.

The Shire of Wongan-Ballidu will continue to work closely with both Federal and State Governments to provide future improvement where possible to our road networks.
