



## RESTRICTED BURNING PERIOD

The prohibited burning period for the Shire of Wongan-Ballidu will end of February 13th with the restricted burning period beginning on February 14th.

Please note all burning within the restricted period requires a permit from your local Fire Control Officer (FCO). Contact details can be found on the Shire's website. As we are still experiencing extreme weather, please exercise extreme caution and please follow the advice and instruction of your FCO. Conditions apply to permits stipulating how burning shall be carried out. Any burning carried out without a permit or without following applied conditions are subject to fines.

All burning is prohibited on days of very high or above fire danger ratings, or if a total fire ban or harvest and movement ban has been implemented.
