# BULK WASTE MANAGEMENT & TRAILER HIRE

The Shire of Wongan-Ballidu has purchased a new trailer for residents to hire in replacement of the verge side bulk waste collection for Wongan Hills and Ballidu townsite residents.

The Shire's Strategic Community Plan outlines our goal to lead by example for sustainability practices in both environment and business. By introducing this new service, materials will be better recycled reducing the amount of waste to landfill. It is also better value for money for rate payers after conducting budget modelling and analytical studies of our previous processes.

The hire of the trailer will be free of charge to eligible residents and will be dropped off at your property and collected at the end of hire.
